

**MARSHAL'S REPORT**  
**January 8<sup>TH</sup> through February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009**

January 9<sup>th</sup>, 10:56 am- The Marshal's Office assisted the DEA task force at a local business. Three males were charged with possession of a controlled substance.

January 14<sup>th</sup>, 4:49 pm- The Alta Ski Patrol, Marshal's Office, Medical Clinic, Unified Fire Authority and a Life Flight helicopter responded to a the Alta Ski area in response to a 15 year old female that became separated from her family while skiing. She was located off trail and unresponsive. Immediate resuscitation efforts were made and she was flown to Primary Children's Medical Center where she later died. The Marshal's Office is awaiting a final report from the State Medical Examiner.

January 16<sup>th</sup>, 10:12 am- A male was arrested for theft of services after being caught skiing with another person's pass.

January 17<sup>th</sup>, 4:05 pm- A search and rescue call-out involving members of the Alta and Snowbird Ski Patrols was initiated in the White Pine area for a man reported overdue/missing in the backcountry. The man was located uninjured and reunited with his family.

January 18<sup>th</sup>, 3:14 pm- The deputy on duty was called to one of the local lodges regarding an agitated man who had come up from Salt Lake to "collect a debt". The man readily admitted to being a drug dealer and couldn't quite understand why he was not welcome. After some conversation with the deputy, the man, his girlfriend, and the person they were looking were all assisted down the canyon.

January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 4:39 pm- A report of a stolen property was taken. The suspect is one of the three people mentioned above. Go figure...

January 24<sup>th</sup>, 10:53 am- A 54 year old male was transported to a local hospital via ambulance after suffering a stroke near one of the parking areas. At 1:22 pm, the Hellgate/Superior area was closed and placed on Interlodge travel restriction. The remainder of town was placed on Interlodge at 10:30 pm.

**January 25<sup>th</sup>, 8:35 am-**      **Avalanche control work was conducted and Interlodge restrictions were lifted. Avalanche control work was again carried out in the mid-canyon at 3:00 pm.**

**January 26<sup>th</sup>, 12:30 am-**      **The Highway was closed and the Town of Alta was placed on Interlodge pending avalanche control work. The restrictions were lifted at 8:30 am.**

**January 27<sup>th</sup>, 12:30 pm-**      **A theft of cash between co-workers at a local business was investigated.**

**January 28<sup>th</sup>, 12:00 pm-**      **The Hellgate/Superior area was closed and placed on Interlodge.**

**January 29<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 am-**      **The Town of Alta was placed on Interlodge for avalanche control work. Restrictions were lifted at 7:28 am.**

**January 30<sup>th</sup> through February 5<sup>th</sup>-**      **Highway avalanche rescue training and drills were conducted in town involving Wasatch Backcountry Rescue volunteers and other public safety agencies. A crushed car that was used throughout the week as a training tool prompted MANY inquiries by citizens concerned that a true emergency was being ignored.**

**February 8<sup>th</sup> 10:01 am-**      **An actual rollover accident (with no injuries) occurred on the highway near the Wildcat Parking area. Only one person noticed and called it in.**
