

**Marshal's Report
April 13th - May 18th
2006**

April 14, 2006 The Department took a report of a cell phone that was lost in the Alta Ski area. At 3:35 pm the Deputy was called to the Snowpine Lodge to keep the peace while some disgruntled employees vacated the premises.

April 15, 2006 12:55 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of Town was closed and interlodged due to wet slide activity. 1:37 pm the Deputy took a crash report when a motorist traveling down the canyon, obviously did not see the closed avalanche gate leading into the Hellgate area. There was damage to the vehicle and the gate.

April 17, 2006 3:00 pm the Marshal was dispatched to the Alta Ski Lifts to arrest a local employee for theft of services. The employee was using another person's season pass to ski in the area. 4:00 pm the Hellgate, Superior section of Town was closed and interlodged due to the increasing avalanche hazard.

April 18, 2006 12:30 am the Town of Alta and all of Little Cottonwood Canyon were closed and interlodged due to the avalanche hazard. 6:30 am avalanche control work was carried out on slide paths that affect the highway. The restrictions were lifted at 7:41 am.

April 19, 2006 A report was taken from an Alta Peruvian employee that had his Ipod stolen.

April 20, 2006 3:25 pm a man walking in the area of Martha Road reported that he was attacked by three dogs. The man was not injured and the suspect dog owner was reprimanded about the leash law.

April 22, 2006 3:00 pm the Deputy was dispatched to the Goldminer's Daughter Lodge to deal with an unwanted intoxicated lodge guest. At 4:16 pm the Hellgate, Superior area was closed and interlodged due to wet slide activity.

May 7, 2006 3:55 pm the Marshal's and the UFA were dispatched to a medical emergency involving an injured skier near the bottom of the Collins Lift at the Alta Ski Area. The young female patient was transported to the hospital by ambulance.

May 13, 2006 8:09 am the Alta Deputy assisted the County Sheriffs with a vehicle crash in the lower canyon near Lisa Falls. No injuries were reported.

May 16, 2006 8:04 pm the Deputy again assisted the Sheriffs Office with a vehicle that left the road in the area of seven turns. The two female occupants were transported by ambulance to the hospital.
