

Marshal's Report
April 13 - May 10, 2007

April 14, 2007 4:16 pm the Alta Marshal's and UFA were dispatched to the Grizzly Gulch area on a medical emergency. It involved a 21 year old male who had gone off a jump while skiing or snowboarding and injured his hip. With the help of the Alta Ski Patrol the patient was stabilized and moved to the Grizzly parking area and transported to hospital by ambulance.

April 15, 2007 6:48 pm a 48 year old male was assessed by the UFA after he had taken a serious fall through the rocks in hopes of recovering the wine bottle he dropped on top of the High Rustler Ski run. He had numerous cuts and abrasions and was advised to seek medical attention at a hospital. After refusing medical attention and an ambulance, the medical team offered him a free ride to the hospital, convincing that he was seriously hurt.

April 20, 2007 10:45 am the Alta deputy assisted the County Sheriff's with a vehicle crash in the lower canyon.
