

MARSHAL'S REPORT
APRIL 9TH-MAY 13TH, 2009

April 13th, 4:55 pm- A theft of personal belongings was reported at one of the local lodges.

April 14th, 10:00 pm-The Hellgate/Superior area was placed on Interlodge. The remainder of the Town of Alta was interlodged at 6:45 am the following morning. Avalanche control work was conducted and restrictions were lifted at 7:27 am.

April 16th, 5:45 am- Interlodge restrictions were again put into effect for avalanche control until 7:45 am. At 4:05 pm, a hit and run accident was investigated in the Flagstaff parking area.

April 17th, 3:10 pm- The Hellgate superior area was closed because of heating and wet slide potential. At 6:09 pm, the deputy on duty assisted the Sheriff's Office with a motorcycle accident in the lower canyon.

April 19th, 1040 am- Last day of the 08/09 ski season. The Marshal's Office investigated the death of a 28 year old male in a guest room at the Alta Peruvian Lodge. The investigation continues pending a report from the State Medical Examiner's Office.

The canyon highway was also closed from 3:15 pm until 6:00 pm due to heating in the avalanche paths above the road.

At 8:09 pm, an unclaimed and disorderly male was transported to the county jail and booked for public intoxication.

April 20th-May 3rd- numerous closures of the Hellgate/Superior area were necessary due to warming weather.

May 9th, 11:00 am- A theft report was received regarding a female who had apparently left town at the end of the season with property belonging to her employer.
